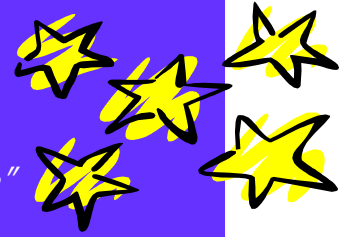

COMPLIANCE CHECKS

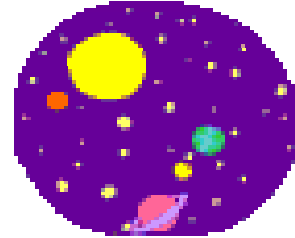
The Danyaville Police Department has conducted its first set of compliance checks!!! Violations were cited at eight out of 10 local liquor stores. Each of the stores that violated the Minimum Purchase Age laws were fined and provided merchant education information developed by the DPAP. Five additional sets of compliance checks will be conducted in the next 6 months.

MEDIA ADVOCACY

With the assistance of Aynad Communications, a new public service announcement (PSA) was developed to communicate the dangers of youth substance use. The PSA will air beginning on July 1 and continue throughout the summer. Two more PSAs are scheduled for development and release in the fall.
